REOPENING OF CONSTRUCTION SITES

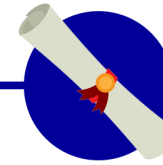

is up to date.

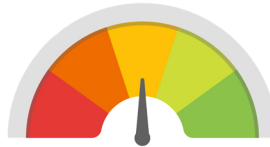
LETTER OF GOODSTANDING

RE-COMMUNICATION OF ALL RISK ASSESSMENTS



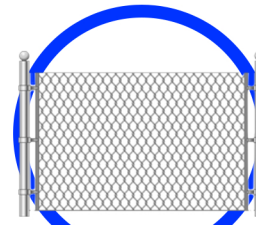
ensure that employees are fully aware of identified hazards, associated risks, and the necessary control measures to maintain a safe and compliant work environment.

ALL EMPLOYEES ON SITE



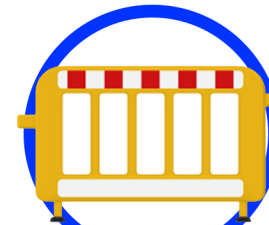
employees are to be updated on safety protocols, site hazards, emergency procedures, and any changes to the work environment or regulations.

INSPECTIONS TO COMPLETE



SITE BOUNDARY

Ensure no damages to site boundary fence.



EDGE BARRICADING

No damage on any edge barricading.



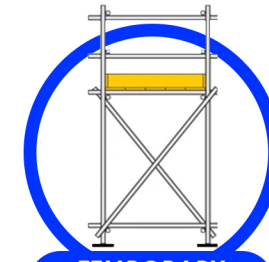
WORK AREAS

Work areas to ensure that it is safe before work commences.



TOOLS

To ensure that any hand tools, portable electrical tools are safe for use.



TEMPORARY STRUCTURES

Any structure that was left in place will need to be re-inspected prior to starting up.



FALL PROTECTION

Ensure fall arrest and fall prevention equipment are safe for use.
